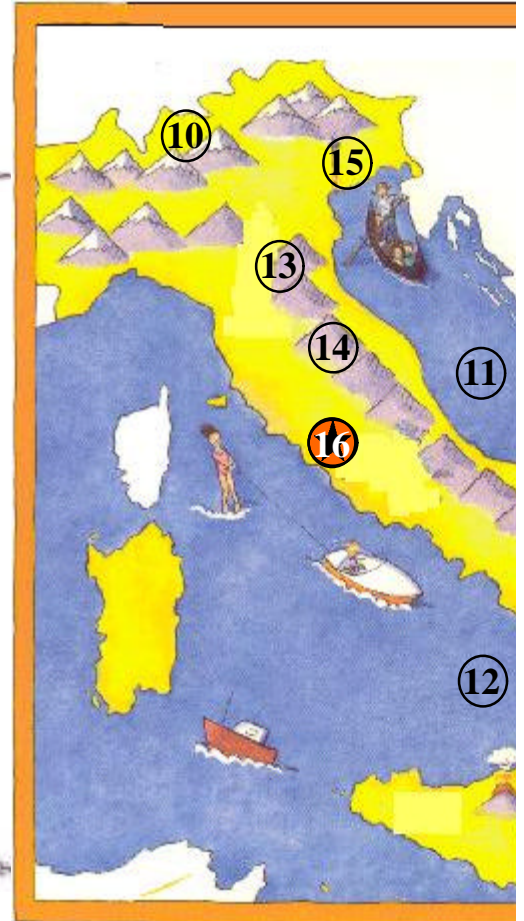
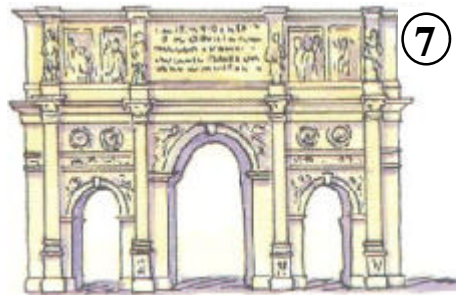
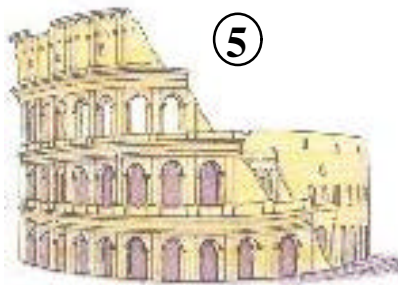
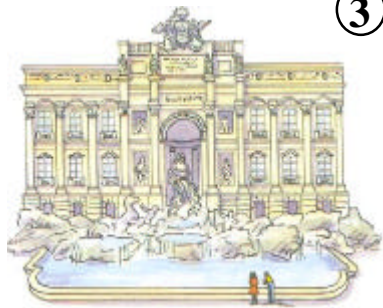
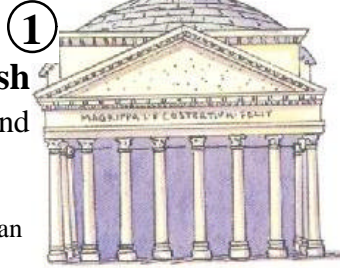
St. Peter's Basilica—
