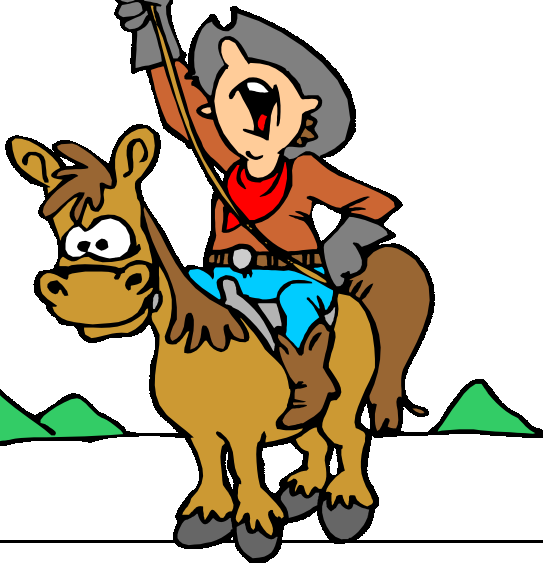
Invented the telegraph and code used for communication.
